Intersystem Cards are also known as Out of System Cards.

In addition to issuing library cards to persons from counties within our own system area, the Wisconsin Statutes, 43.24 (2) (e) (3) states that systems, in order to qualify for state aids, must have "service agreements with all adjacent systems..."

The Wisconsin Valley Library System has the following inter-system agreement with adjacent library systems:

An On-Site Borrowing (OSB) agreement allows residents of one system to have library cards from other systems.
