Intersystem Cards are also known as Out of System Cards.

In addition to issuing library cards to persons from counties within our own system area, the <u>Wisconsin Statutes</u>, 43.24(2)(e)(3) states that systems, in order to qualify for state aids, must have "service agreements with all adjacent systems..."
