keep kids reading, engaged and having fun.


Complete a reading BINGO card and earn up to two free books. Different BINGO cards are available for pre-readers, schoolaged readers, and young adults.

Historic maps added to digitization project!

Historic Marathon County maps and plat books have been added to the Central Wisconsin Digitization Project! These publications are from 1882, 1895 and 1901. In addition, there is a book that shows the evolution of the townships in Marathon County.

The scan of the 1882 map was made from an original that was donated to the library by Malcolm Rosholt. He received it from Mable Whitely, who was the daughter of a local lumberman. This scan includes notes regarding the locations of possible lumber camps.

The 1901 map includes plats of a number of smaller towns and villages in Marathon County, and a farmer's directory that lists names of farmers in the area. This list is a potential boon for genealogists searching for local families. While the "Wausau City Directories" also includes farmers from around Marathon County, this resource lists only farmers.

Probably the most interesting of the group is "The Evolution of Townships for Marathon County." This book was created by the Marathon County Highway Department in the mid 1960s and shows step by step how the land that became Marathon County was divided up into Townships. Each page shows the change and notes the date of the township's founding, as well as some election dates. This was a fun find and a neat way to explain the changes that made Marathon County the place it is today.

Wi-Fi hotspots now available for checkout!

The Marathon County Public Library is pleased to announce a new Wi-Fi hotspot lending program at all nine of its locations!

Two Wi-Fi hotspot kits are available for checkout at each MCPL location. These

mobile hotspots provide an internet connection in locations where a cellular signal is already available. (If no cell signal is available, the devices will not work.) Each kit contains a single hotspot, a micro-USB cable, an AC charter with USB port and simple instructions.

Each hotspot can be borrowed for two weeks, with the option to renew if no other patrons have requested the device. These devices are not yet listed in the library's online catalog and must be requested in person or by calling your local MCPL. A fine of \$1 per day will be charged for each day the device is overdue.

To be eligible to check out a hotspot, a patron must be a MCPL cardholder and at least 18 years old. The patron also must not already have access to equipment or internet services sufficient to meet their educational needs. Patrons are also required to sign a user agreement upon checkout.

This pilot program will run through at least the end of 2023, at which point the program will be evaluated.


