

# Lactation Pod @ MCPL Wausau

Breastfeeding, pumping or nursing parents seeking comfort and privacy now have a convenient option at MCPL Wausau!

In January, the library installed a Mamava lactation pod. A lactation pod is a freestanding,

enclosed structure that provides a private, safe, peaceful and clean space for nursing parents. It also has easy-to-access outlets for pumping equipment.

MCPL Wausau's lactation pod is located on the first floor by the entrance to Youth Services. The pod is free to use and can be accessed with the free Mamava app, or by getting a code from Youth Services or the Main Desk.



# Celebrate the solar eclipse!

All nine MCPL locations plan to celebrate the 2024 total solar eclipse! As part of a grant, MCPL received solar eclipse glasses to give away for free. These glasses will be prioritized for eclipse program participants (see events marked with a inside this newsletter), but they also may be picked up on a "first come, first served" basis at all MCPL locations starting April 1.

The solar eclipse will occur on Monday, April 8, and glasses will be handed out until this date (while supplies last).

Please note: The free eclipse glasses will be limited to one pair per person—or two per group—so there will be enough for everyone. The eclipse will last about three hours, so we encourage folks and families to share glasses if possible. We also recommend glasses for children 8 years old or older so they can better understand the experience and what is happening.


